

Selection Guidelines of 2022 Asian Games

A. General

The 2022 Asian Games will take place from 10 to 25 September 2022 in Hangzhou, China.

B. Eligibility

In order to be eligible to participate in the selection a participant must be:

1. Used valid equipment followed by class rules in the indicator event; and
2. Holder of HKSAR Passport.

C. Number of Place

One competitor from Hong Kong will compete in each of the following windsurfing Classes;

1. iQFOiL Men
2. iQFOiL Women
3. RS:X Men
4. RS:X Women

Note: The coach panel will make the final recommendation on each class in term of the potential of winning.

D. Method of Selection

The selection consists of 2 parts: Results in the indicator event (Part 1) and coach recommendation (Part 2).

Part 1: Results in the indicator event(s)

An indicator ranking will be separately created for iQFOiL Men and Women. The selection by results will use the following indicator event;

- 2021 iQFOiL National Team selection competition (4 – 31 December, Hong Kong)

An indicator ranking will be separately created for RS:X Men and Women. The selection by results will use the following indicator event;

- 2022 RS:X National Team selection competition (15 – 30 January, Hong Kong)

Note: A replacement event(s) will be arranged only if the events above are not valid.

Part 2: Coach Recommendation

The panel of coaches including:

- Chan King Yin, National coach
- Zee Winfield, Windsurfing Coach
- Cheng Kwok Fai, Windsurfing Coach
- Man Ka Kei, Assistant Windsurfing coach
- Leung Ho Tsun, Assistant Windsurfing coach
- Lee Chun Ting, Assistant Windsurfing coach

The coach in-charge of the iQFoil and RS:X programme will prepare a coach recommendation report. The following will be taken into account:

1. Potential to win medals in the 2022 Asian Games;
2. Performance and previous results in the last 12 months;
3. Attendance rate and training commitment;
4. Behavior according to the WAHK National Squad Code of Conduct;
5. Commitment and performance in training;
6. Commitment to the preparation for the 2022 Asian Games; and
7. Injuries, illness and material damage where and when found applicable

Notes:

The following criteria will also apply after the selection has finished;

1. The selected athletes are expected to continue training under the program as set out by the National Windsurfing Coach to further improve fitness and performance towards these events and remain free of performance inhibiting injuries. If a selected athlete is unable to meet these criteria a replacement or alternative selection programme may be put forward by the National Windsurfing Coach for the WAHK General Committee's endorsement.
2. In case any selected athlete withdraws, or is injured, or cannot compete due to other reasons, his/her place may be filled by the next ranked competitor on the respective indicator ranking.

E. Final Decision

The selection report will be submitted to the Windsurfing Association of Hong Kong General Committee which will be the final endorsing authority. Any appeals must be directed to the Windsurfing Association of Hong Kong General Committee in a timely fashion, as soon as possible after the outcome of the selections has been announced. At its discretion the Windsurfing Association of Hong Kong General Committee may appoint an Appeal Working Party, with a legal adviser as a member of the party, to decide on the validity of the appeal and the outcome.
